Please find enclosed the text of a Motion regarding nuclear power generation passed at a public meeting that was organized by Veterans Against Nuclear Arms at St. Andrews United Church, Toronto, on April 24, 2012 and co-sponsored by the Hiroshima Day Coalition, Voice of Women and Science for Peace. Fifty people attended the meeting.

Veterans Against Nuclear Arms was founded by World War II veterans in 1982. Despite a very aging membership, VANA still has 42 members in their eighties and nineties.

It is our hope that the Ontario government will abandon its planned investment of billions of dollars in nuclear power generation with its attendant radioactive nuclear waste and constant cost overruns and invest in renewable energy instead.
